 - Leaning solar lamppost March Road: Council approved payment to have this straightened. The Clerk will then try and recover costs from Westcotec.
 - Cllr Goodger reported a pothole between 2 and 4 Hurn Drove. The Clerk will report on the portal.

 - *i* To discuss any planning applications:
- Planning Application Consultation 25/00087/F. Demolish the existing UPVC conservatory which is in a poor state of repair and build a rear 2 storey extension with a pitched slate roof and solar panels and other alterations to dwelling. Demolish the existing timber barn to the north of the house and replace it with a two-bay timber cart lodge with attached workshops (for private use by the householders) at Meadow Farm Main Street Welney Wisbech PE14 9RB. Welney PC supports this application.
 - ii To note any Highways and Wash Road updates:

Cllr Goodger reported the new flood signs are gradually going up. The white posts in the flood area are due to be replaced. The cameras are soon to be re calibrated.

iii To discuss additional streetlights in the Parish and the current streetlights:

The Clerk has received quotes to replace the blue lights in the Parish. Council requires further information on new streetlights, how many hours do they last for and what is the warranty? The Clerk will also ask for a
