- 3. To approve the Minutes from the last meeting: these were approved and signed by the Chair
- **4.** To declare any conflicts and pecuniary interests on any items on this month's Agenda: Cllrs Goodger and Barker for Marshalls Charity

- 6. To discuss and consider the Action Log from previous meetings:
- Verge white lines, Highways have put in an order for this.
- Overgrown trod between Sandgate and Stockyard farm, highways have agreed this can be sprayed
- Taymour Place pavements are programmed in for September 2022
- Investigate the old Barclays Bank accounts. Councillors Gardiner and Goodger will contact the business team.
- The loose railing near the phone box, highways have programmed this in.
- The loose curbs at Hale Drove have been marked by Highways ready to repair.
- New sign saying Children's play area: the Clerk has reported this on the Highways portal.
- New sign saying Sandgate Meadow in Chestnut Ave. The clerk has received two quotes in the region of £520. This will be discussed at the next meeting.
- Bells Drove streetlight, this is still ongoing with Westcotec
- A traffic cone which is covering up the remains of an obsolete or missing traffic sign thought to be a
 triangular series of bends hazard sign. If it's not required it needs to be properly cut back by Highways
 team. Highways team will check this out.
- Redundant post on corner of New Road/ Main Street. This has been reported to Highways.
- Broken Perspex bus table sign. Clerk will report this to get it replaced.
- Blocked drains at Chestnut Ave: Clerk will report this to get them jetted.
- Overgrown trees at Tipps End, the Clerk has asked for addresses so these can be reported to Highways.

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- To discuss plans for Welney Christmas Tree: Councillor Spears reported an artificial tree would cost in the region of £2000. To purchase a real one would be £375. Make 'Welney Beautiful' asked if they purchased the tree would the Parish Council purchase the lights rough cost £100. Councillor Spears will get a quote for the lights. The electricity supply would come from the church for a small donation of £25. A carol service could be held at the same time. This could also be linked with the Lamb and Flag serving mulled wine; Cllr Spears will speak with them.
- **8.** To discuss a wish list for Parish Partnership Scheme and CIL grants: it was agreed for the Clerk to apply for two defibulators and three streetlights through CIL.

Councillor Goodger said that the number of trustees was being looked at and would go down to nine, three of whom would be Parish Council Representees.
